<b>Drop-Off:</b>	Please sign in your child at the front desk between 8:00AM and no later than 8:50AM. Camp announcements begin at 8:50AM and Camp begins promptly at 9:00AM.
<b>Pick-Up:</b>	<p><b>Half-Day Campers</b> should be picked up between 12:45PM and <b>no later than 1:00PM.</b> (Full-Day Campers leave with staff for Fieldtrips at 1:00PM.)</p> <p><b>Full-Day Campers</b> should be picked up between 4:00PM and <b>no later than 6:30PM.</b></p> <p>Campers will only be released to individuals listed on the “Pick-Up Authorization” form.</p> <p><b>Parents will be charged a rate of \$1 per minute they are late after pick up time.</b></p> <p><b>Pick up for Half-Day campers is NO LATER THAN 1:00PM.</b></p> <p><b>Pick up for Full-Day campers is NO LATER THAN 6:30PM</b></p> <p>AM and PM Staff changes occur during the lunch hour. The late pick up fee will be used to cover the added cost of keeping staff on duty. PM Staffers cannot stay with Half-Day campers as their duties with the Full-Day campers commence upon the staffers’ arrival. As such, AM Staffers will be required to stay with Half-Day campers until they are picked up by an authorized individual.</p>
<b>Dress Code:</b>	<p>Comfortable play clothes that can get dirty. Remember that the children may be cooking, painting, or doing science experiments.</p> <p>For Outdoor Water Play: <b>Boys should wear swim trunks and a shirt</b> to shield from the sun. <b>Girls should wear a one piece swimsuit and shorts.</b> Tankinis for girls are acceptable only if they wear shorts. <b>Bikini swimsuits will NOT be appropriate for the outdoor activities planned.</b></p> <p><b>Any child not properly attired for Outdoor Water Play will not be allowed to participate.</b></p> <p>To protect little feet, swim shoes, athletic sandals, or tennis shoes to wear outside are a good idea, but not required. (They will get wet!) <b>Flip flops and crocs will not be appropriate for the outdoor activities planned.</b></p> <p>Every child is required to wear a gi (uniform) during Aikido classes. The gi will be provided to the children on the first day of camp, and is theirs to keep.</p>

**Medication:** Although our camp staffers are trained in CPR and AED, we are **NOT** permitted to dispense prescription medication to children.

**Weather:** Our camp mostly takes place inside a *state-of-the-art* Martial Arts facility. As such, if North Fulton area businesses are open for business, the camp will be open.

**The camp closes, when area businesses close due to inclement weather.**

**What to bring:** **Water or milk** to drink with lunch. Please provide a **healthy lunch**. We will provide the healthy snacks. Please be conscious of the fact that we will have campers with food allergies, when you pack your child's lunch. No loose nuts, please.

**(We provide one snack for Half-Day Campers and two snacks for Full-Day Campers.)**

**Sunscreen, swimsuit, towel, and plastic bag for wet suit and towel.**  
 Children must be able to apply their own sunscreen.

**PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING: LUNCH BOXES, SWIMSUITS AND EVEN CLOTHING. THE CHILDREN WILL BE CHANGING INTO SWIMSUITS, AND GIs (UNIFORMS), AND BACK INTO THEIR CLOTHING AGAIN. IT HELPS THEM AND STAFF, IF THEIR NAMES OR INITIALS ARE WRITTEN IN SHARPIE ON THE CLOTHING. GIs (UNIFORMS) WILL BE PRELABELED BY CAMP STAFF.**

**(You'd be surprised how easy it is for kids to mix up which clothing belongs to which kid!)**

**Sick Campers:** Children who get sick at camp will be brought to the front lobby where they will be comforted and wait for their parents to pick them up.

If a child's sickness causes an absence of 2 or more days of camp during a one week period, the child will be allowed to make up those missed days in a subsequent camp in 2010, and parents will be given the option of purchasing remaining days needed to complete the subsequent camp at a prorated price. **Refunds will not be given.**

**Refunds:** **A full refund will be given when a 2 week notice** of withdrawal is given.

**A 50% refund will be given, when a one week notice** of withdrawal is given.

**Prohibited Items:** **Please leave the following items at home:** electronics, trading cards, novelty items, gum, candy, music devices, weapons, money, toys, cell phones, I-pods, DS, MP3, or any other hand held game systems. Please do not allow children to dress in inappropriate clothing that promote alcohol, tobacco, or vulgar slogans.
