

CHILDREN TESTING

- Placing your name on the sign-up sheet means that you wish to be considered for testing. It does not mean you will be asked to actually test. Your instructors will observe you and offer suggestions for improvement. Approximately one week prior to the test date, your instructors will let you know if you will actually be testing.
- You are responsible for learning your test techniques and ki exercises. Please utilize all available resources, including asking your instructors for help and studying the Kihon Waza and Ki Exercise videos. It is strongly suggested that you attend class at least three times per week.
- Testing is meant to be a challenge. Diligent preparation is essential for you to grow as an aikidoka.
- Your Test Application and test fee must be submitted no later than seven (7) days prior to the test date.
- You must submit both the “Good Student” and “Good Citizen” forms no later than seven (7) days prior to the test date. These forms are on the dojo website.
- If your test requirements include an Essay, you must submit that Essay to Goodman Sensei no later than three (3) days prior to the test.
- Dues must be current.
- AWA yearly dues for students ranked 17th Kyu and above (\$20) must also be current.
